

To: Current ODP Certificate Holders

**Re: Changes to Recertification Requirement in Ontario's Refrigerants
Regulation, O. Reg. 189/94**

Under the provisions of a recent amendment to Ontario's *Refrigerants* regulation (O. Reg. 189/94), you are no longer required to undergo re-examination in order to maintain your certification under Ontario's Ozone Depletion Prevention Program.

The recertification requirement is being replaced with a five-year renewal provision. Therefore, ODP certificate holders will be required to update their information and renew their certificate every five years upon payment of a renewal fee.

Please note that it is advisable to contact JTAC as soon as possible to avoid a lapse in your certification. You will be required to complete the full day course and examination required for first-time certifiers if your certificate expires prior to renewal.
